PROVISIONAL DETERMINATION OF AMMONITES
COLLECTED BY HUBACH

- Hu-703 Silesites ? (Hauterivian-Albian)
Deformed fragments. Determination doubtful because neither the suture nor constructions are preserved.
- Hu-1259 Gauthiericeras U. Turonian-Coniacian.
Small and large specimens. There are doubts as to whether these forms are true Gauthiericeras or belong perhaps to Barroisiceras or Prionocyclus; in any case similar forms are frequent in "La Luna" beds of the Upper Valley.
- Hu-1260 Gauthiericeras U. Turonian-Coniacian
Many small specimens. (see note above)
Hoplitoides ? (Turonian-Coniacian)
Large fragment determined from the suture; otherwise not typical.
- Hu-1347 Muniericeras Coniacian
Two specimens without suture. One similar specimen is available from "La Luna" beds of the Upper Valley.
Paralenticeras Coniacian
Small specimens without suture. Similar forms are frequent in "La Luna" beds of the Upper Valley
Hyphantoceras ? (Turonian-Senonian)
Fragment without suture.
- Hu-1350 Baculites ? (U. Albian-Senonian)
Small fragment without suture or ornamentation.

The ammonites Hu-1336, 1340, 1345, 1346 and 1354 could not be determined.
